

Information on Doctoral admissions with MEXT scholarship-October 2024 intake

We are pleased to announce that the application to the International Graduate Program on Civil and Environmental Engineering, funded by the MEXT Scholarship program, is now open. Though the application period for October 2024 intake is short, we welcome applications that meet the following criteria.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR A MEXT SCHOLARSHIP

- be a national of a country where the Japanese Government Scholarship is offered.
- be under 35 years of age as of April 1, 2024. (i.e., born on or after April 2, 1989)

December 20 (Wed), 2023	Deadline for receiving applications for the October 2024 intake (Please consult with us if you cannot send the full application documents by the deadline)
Late January	Notification of results to short-listed candidates
January 29-February 9, 2024	Internet-based interviews for short-listed candidates
Mid-March	Notification of results to successful applicants
September 25, 2024 (tentative)	Graduate program begins

- b. Copies of the official academic transcripts stating the grades obtained in the previous undergraduate and graduate programs (signed and sealed by the university).
- c. Copy of the certificate of graduation
(undergraduate and graduate programs) (signed and sealed by the university)
- d. Two sealed letters of recommendation (Form B)
- e. Essays on the selected topics (Form C), the applicant must adhere to the word requirements of the essays mentioned in the forms.
- f. A concise resume (Form D)
- g. Certificate of English proficiency: Department institutional code for TOEFL: 7314
